QUIET PLEASE!

A decade or so ago much was being said about noise pollution. The jet planes were breaking the sound barrier and air travel became more and more popular creating an: awfully lot of noise. Today, we have almost gotten used to the acceleration of road traffic and noise of the Interstates and Highways. Then there is the noise of our television almost immediately upon entering our homes. Have we become afraid of the quietness? It is interesting to see how often the bible informs us of the need to be guiet. Let's take a look: "...a time to rend, and a time to sew, a time to keep silent (Eccl. 3:7) -- but the Lord is in his holy temple, let all the earth keep silence before him. (Hab. 2:20) – stand still and know the wondrous works of the Lord (Job 37:14) – be still, and know that I am God (Psa. 46:10) – he leadeth me: beside the still (quiet) waters (Psa. 23:2)." These are but a few passages which show the importance of quiet time. Have you ever watched the very ill who seemingly cannot find a quiet time and how they struggle with themselves until they are worn out? When finally they drop off to sleep and all is quiet, how peaceful and serene it is.. We must: make time for quietness more than we do. Our Lord thought so as he went upon a: mountain to pray and get away from the crowd (Matt. 14:23). We need to find such a place more often.
