

FROM "A" to "Z" Dennis Smith

Here is an old expression which we have heard all our lives. We use it to denote completeness, length of years or even to brag about certain things. For example: "What can you tell me about Brother John?" The reply: "Well, I've known him forever - even from 'A' to 'Z'" The Lord, in speaking to the Apostle John, used this same idea four times in describing himself, only he used the Greek Alphabet to do so. "I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty" (Rev. 1:8, 10; 21:6; 22:13). What a way to tell the world about himself! It was as though he was verifying what had been declared about him from the first chapter of the Bible to the last. He was with God in the beginning (Gen. 1:26) and the co-creator with God in setting in motion "all things" (John 1:1-3). He will also be the Victorious Lord when the time comes to end all things (1 Cor. 15:57). Knowing this should make us want to begin our lives - live our lives - and have him with us in the end. There is a wonderful old hymn which should say it all: "He is my everything, He is my all. He is my everything, both great and small. He gave his life for me - made everything new. He is my everything, now how about you?" Do you know him from "A to Z"? You can - you know (2 Tim 2:15)!
