#### GOD AND PAIN

In his book *The Cross of Christ*, John Stott wrote, "I could never myself believe in God, if it were not for the cross .... In the real world of pain, how could one worship a God who is immune to it? ... He laid aside his immunity to pain. He entered our world of flesh and blood, tears and death. He suffered for us. Our sufferings become more manageable in the light of his." (p. 335, 336)

The problem of pain is, and always has been, a severe challenge to faith. God does not offer a detailed defense of Himself nor an explanation of His rule over a world where suffering exists. He does offer His Son to redeem us from it.

We wish pain were gone. Some day it will be. In the meantime, we are strengthened by remembering what was accomplished when Christ suffered for sins. A writer unknown to me put it this way:

The cry of man's anguish went up to God, "Lord, take away pain! The shadow that darkens the world thou hast made; The close, coiling chain That strangles the heart; the burden that weighs Our wings that would soar. Lord, take away pain from the world Thou hast made That it love Thee the more."

Then answered the Lord to the cry of the world, "Shall I take away pain,
And with it the power of the soul to endure,
Made strong by the strain?
Shall I take away pity that knits heart to heart,
And sacrifice high?
Will you lose all your heroes that lift from the fire
White brows to the sky?
Shall I take away love that redeems with a price,
And smiles with your loss?
Can you spare from your life that would cling unto mine
The Christ on His Cross?"

No, we can't. He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows. He was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities, and chastised for our peace. With his stripes we are healed. Some things are accomplished through suffering that can't be done any other way.



#### HE'S IN THE AIR WE BREATHE

This last year has been flooded with warnings about the H1N1 virus which has swept across our land. Many have received inoculations as a protection from being afflicted. It is always good advice to take every precaution where our physical health is concerned. There is a far worse pandemic that has plagued the world from the beginning which seems to be of little concern to some today. Like many of the physical diseases which afflict our bodies, the disease of sin spreads quickly as if it is contacted out of the air we breathe. Sin is sin on any level and there is "no new thing under the sun" (Eccl. 1:9), but to some it seems there are more "exciting new sins" sweeping across the world which they have to try out. Have you ever considered how the "prince of the power of the air" (Eph. 2:2) uses the air to present his temptations to us. I'm talking about the air waves which bring radio and television into our living rooms with the most violent acts of lewd and immoral suggestions.
