#### "WHY HAS YOUR COUNTENANCE FALLEN?"

In the King James Translation of the Holy Bible, the word "countenance" is used dozens of times. Even in some of the newer versions, like the New American Standard, you will also see this word used. In both translations referred to here, the first time this word appears is in Genesis 4:5-6 when God rejected the offering made by Cain, the first son of Adam and Eve. It was rejected simply because Cain had rendered an improper offering. "So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell. Then the Lord said to Cain, Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?" In short the word "countenance" means: "Face or facial expression." When one is sad and brokenhearted it most usually shows in the face. But it can also mean "I'm sending you a fiery message." I sometimes received this type of signal as a little boy from my mother. Seriously, sometimes we send these expressions to others without saying a word. However, by the look on our face, we might as well have gone ahead with a verbal message. I think what I'm saying is that by our facial expression others may have an unkind image of what we must be as a person. This is so unbecoming a child of God. We often send messages by our countenance. Let us be sure that ours always reflect upon the righteousness of the Lord. (See Psalm 11:7).
