Coping With Life

Responsibilities. Heartbreaks. Anxieties. We all know that life can be overwhelming. Being God's children doesn't shield us from such experiences, nor does it necessarily keep these feelings from arising. Christians do, however, have a way of thinking which enables us to live strong.

"I cannot do everything." No one can. The Lord does not expect me to. Sensible thinking requires that I not consider myself more highly than I ought, but to realize that not everything depends on me (cf. Rom. 12:3). One person can only do so much good.

"I can do <u>nothing</u> apart from the Lord." I am not in this on my own strength alone. The Lord wants me to remember this, for he said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing" (Jn. 15: 5). My first concern is to abide in Christ.

"I can do <u>something</u>." Paul said, "But one thing I do..." (cf. Phil. 3:13). What if I take one thing at a time and do what I can about it? I am not the whole body but I am one member. There is a place for me. I want to meet my responsibility.

"I can do <u>all things</u> that I really need to do." It may not be all that I wish I could do, or what someone else expects me to do, but I can do what the Lord wants me to do. "I can do all things through him who strengthens me" (Phil. 4:13).

"Whatever I do with this spirit will be enough." I will have done my best, and that's all the Lord expects of me. I can lay it in his hands and let his peace guard my heart.

"Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ" (1 Pet. 1:13).

STRIVING FOR OUR CROWN

The meaning of the word "strive" is simply "making the most effort." Those of us who have become children of God are those responding by faith to the commands of our Lord and putting him on in scriptural baptism (Gal. 3:26-27). As we "grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ" (2nd Pet. 3:18), we learn that effort has to be made on our part to be included in those who will be rewarded the "crown of life" in the day of judgment (Rev. 2:10). The Apostle Paul informs us as Christians to make every effort to Strive for Our Crown (1st Cor. 9:25; 2nd Tim. 2:5). In these two texts he uses the ancient games of the Romans in two separate ways as metaphors to our striving. They are: (1) We must make every effort to insure that we are qualified to even be in the game. (2) After being qualified to enter, we must make every effort to "...exercise ourselves unto godliness" (1st Tim. 4:7). How unfortunate it is when people will claim to be a servant of the Lord on the strength of their faith only but never make any effort to strive for their crown by assisting in the work of the Lord. Perhaps a look at James 2:18 will verify what this article is suggesting. "Yes, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: show me thy faith without thy works, and I will show thee my faith by my works." The bottom line then is this: If we really want to receive our crown of righteousness, we must make every effort to obtain it.
