#### **KINDRED SCRIPTURE - KINDRED THOUGHTS**

It is interesting to see how that certain passages from God's Word match up even though the wording may be somewhat different. For example: Last week's article (The Abundant Life) showed how this is true. John 10:10 matched up with 1st Tim. 4:8. It also matches up with 1st Peter 3:10 showing that the good life is in harmony with the abundant life with the Lord who watches over his flock. There are many others with kindred thoughts." Take for example these three words: believe, repent and baptism. The Golden Text of the Bible (John 3:16) stresses the importance of believing in the Son of God. Luke 13:3, 5 stresses the importance of repenting. Jesus stresses the importance of baptism (Mark 16:15-16). When Peter stood up on Pentecost day and replied to the question "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" he brought together all three of these words into one grand statement: "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ" (Acts 2:38). It is obvious in reading the entire text of Acts 2 that Peter was stressing the importance of believing throughout his sermon. If you have any problem with these being kindred because the word "believe" is not openly mentioned by Peter, just take the time to read Mark 16:16; "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved." Using kindred scripture as your guide will lead you to a magnificent connection with God, giving you a kindred spirit as his child (Gal. 3:26-27).

#### **Ownership**

A worker in a St. Louis area Goodwill Store discovered \$14,505 in a box of donated clothing. No sooner had word of the find gotten out than fifteen people came forward to claim that it is theirs! It's amazing that so many people keep that much cash around the house in boxes of clothing no longer being used, isn't it?

This episode may remind us of a couple of odd things about human nature. One is how eager we can be to claim ownership of things that are valuable. Whether it is money, or the right to do or say something, or credit for some accomplishment, we are prepared to declare that it belongs to us. Honest thought is no hindrance to our thinking that we deserve ownership.

The other striking thing is how loathe we are to accept responsibility for wrong done. In this case, for example, no one is admitting that he or she acted thoughtlessly and has no real claim on the lost money. Surely it is someone else's fault!

Isn't that how we human beings are? The blame belongs to someone else. The benefit belongs to us. Remember, though, that each of us will give account to the Lord for what we ourselves have done, even for the hidden purposes of our hearts (1 Cor. 3:4,5).
