## REMEMBER

"Remember" may be the most important word in the New Testament with regard to the nature of Christian worship.

The term declares first that the church comes together to do what the Lord wants, not merely what it likes. After all, it was the Lord who took bread and the cup and said, "Do this in remembrance of me" (1 Cor. 11:23-25). The fact that he did so on the night when he was betrayed and at a later time made it known to Paul, who delivered it to the church, tells us that what the church offers to the Lord must be offered in submission to his revealed will.

Remembering also demands the exercise of the mind. Though the whole church may come together, worship occurs only as individual members of the body engage their hearts to recall what the Lord has given for us, understand what his work in our behalf means, and examine themselves in light of that amazing grace. What is guided by truth must be expressed with sincerity.

As the church remembers, it recognizes something which has happened that will not be, and does not need to be, repeated. Christian worship proclaims the once-for-all sacrifice of Christ and offers a sacrifice of praise to God for its sufficiency. The church does not worship for cleansing but because of cleansing.

When the church remembers, it is moved with deep gratitude. The spirit and tone of its worship is thanksgiving. Joyful praise, humble prayer and loving service surely have to be the natural response of those who reflect upon the steadfast love of a wise and powerful God who would offer up his Son for us all.

Those who remember reorient their lives. They reset their affections, their values and their behavior by the example of the one they have been remembering. A worshiper becomes like the one he worships.

This Lord's Day, remember.

#### "FAITH OF THE OPERATION OF GOD"

One of the oft-quoted passages on baptism is Colossians 2:12 which from the King James Version reads as follows: "Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead." Most of the newer versions will read "faith in the workings of God." I don't suppose there is that much difference in these two words but being a part of the military in my younger years and an advocate of the old KJV, it seems that the word "operation" best fits the great plan of God from the foundation of the world (Matt. 25:34; 1st Pet. 1:20). Think with me (by comparison) of the planning of the D-Day operation which launched the landing of the Allied Forces at Normandy on June 6, 1944. Think of the weeks, months, days and even minutes that went into the planning of this invasion. Now, think of God who started the planning for this gigantic operation of bringing salvation to everyone through Jesus Christ. Think of all the "types, shadows and examples" which are given in the Old Testament that match up with the life of Christ in the New Testament. These things give us a picture of the majesty and greatness of God. All the pieces fit together which reminds us that the Bible in its entirety has been given "by the inspiration of God" (2nd Tim. 3:16), that the Son of God, his death on the cross, his instructions to mankind, qualified him to be "the captain of our salvation" (Heb. 2:10).
