

THE PARALLELS OF THE 23RD PSALM

"The LORD is my shepherd" - The Good Cofession - (Matt. 10:32; 16:16; Acts 8:37). "I shall not want." - The provisions of life - (Phil. 4:19; James 1:17). "He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters" - Learning the values of contentment - (1st Tim. 6:6-8). He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake" - Keepping us in line when we get out of line - (James 5:19-20; 1st John 1:9). "Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me" - Salvation through the Word, plus having the promise of our Lord to be with us always - (James 1:21; 2nd Tim. 4:8; Mark 16:16; Rev. 2:10; Matt. 28:20; Heb. 13:5). "Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over" - The values of remembering the Lord's Supper - (Matt. 26:26-29; 1st Cor. 10:21; 11:20 -29). "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever" - (John 14:1-3; James 1:17). Perhaps this little "drill" will help to verify that "all scripture is given by the inspiration of God" (2nd Tim. 3:16-17). This may have a different "twist" to it than you've possibly thought of but if you will take the time to check on these comparisons you surely will be benefited in your faith.
