### The Lord of Life and Light

There is something wonderful to be noticed in the letters of Paul to Timothy. It has everything to do with the reality that governs Christian living and motivates Christian service. It voices the highest aspiration of godliness. It breathes healthy and vital spirituality.

What I am referring to may be observed in a comparison of the beloved apostle's exclamations of praise to the Lord in 1 Timothy. The first comes at 1:17 as he concludes his thanksgiving for the overflowing grace and remarkable mercy which has saved him and appointed him to the service of Christ. He says, "To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen." Take note of his reasons for placing God in the highest place. He is the only King, and he has life, and he is beyond our human view or grasp. Honor belongs to him.

The second comes at 6:15b-16 when the apostle is calling for the good confession to be maintained despite the temptations and snares of materialism. Of the One who will display the Lord Jesus Christ at the proper time, he writes, "He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light,

whom no one has ever seen or can see. To him be honor and eternal dominion. Amen." Notice again his reasons for ascribing the dominion to the Lord. He is the only King, and he alone has life, and he is beyond our view or grasp.

These convictions are what make God, to Paul, God. These truths are, in large measure, what open his heart to the gospel and so impress him with its value. "Our Savior Christ Jesus," he says, "abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel" (2 Tim. 1:10). A King! Life! The light of understanding and access!

No wonder, then, in these very personal and practical letters near the end of his course he urges his beloved child in the faith, "O Timothy, guard the deposit entrusted to you" (1 Tim. 6:20; cf. 2 Tim. 1:14). Don't we need the same spiritual core which led to this charge.



### GOD'S KINGDOM - SPIRITUAL OR PHYSICAL?

In the religious world there has been an ongoing discussion concerning the Kingdom of God. One trail leading back for many years teaches that in the course of time Jesus will return to this earth and establish a physical kingdom with Jerusalem as its Capitol. Should that be the case we would have to conclude that the kingdom would then be physical. On the other hand, making a study of God's kingdom with his Son presiding over it leaves many doubts that it ever was or ever will be a physical kingdom. Both John the Baptist and Jesus prophesied that the "Kingdom was at hand" while they were still on this earth (Matt. 3:2; 4:17). Jesus went so far as to tell his disciples, "There be some of you standing here that will not taste of death until you see the kingdom of God come with power" (Mark 9:1; Matt. 16:28; Luke 9:27). There is then no evidence that a physical kingdom with Christ standing with power in Jerusalem ever existed in the lifetime of his disciples. On the other hand, there is much scriptural evidence that Jesus did (in Jerusalem) establish a spiritual kingdom with Christ as its head and that the kingdom and the church were the same. (See Eph. 1:22; Col. 1:13). Consider this: "God is a Spirit" (John 4:24). "The Father, the Word (Jesus), and the Holy Spirit ...are one" (1st John 5:7). If God is a Spirit then so is the Godhead (Col. 2:9; Acts 17:29; Rom. 1:20). Final conclusion: God's Kingdom from the beginning has been and always will be spiritual.
