

"You Can't Have One Without The Other"

Several decades ago a popular song which had all the young folks singing was "Love and Marriage." Some of the lyrics went like this: "You Can't Have One Without the Other." For a marriage to be successful these two attributes must be present. Be it known that these words are not limited to the subject of marriage. For example: The Apostle Peter talks about the <u>abundant mercy</u> of God (1st Peter 1:3). He also talks about an <u>abundant entrance</u> into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2nd Peter 1:11). Jesus talks about the <u>abundant life</u> which he offers to mankind by the gospel (John 10:10). Let me extend this thought even further. Isaiah promises that if the wicked will forsake his ways and return to the Lord, He will <u>abundantly pardon</u> (Isa. 55:7). The Apostle Paul talks about the <u>operation of God</u> and how it works (Col. 2:12). The interesting thing about all of this is that "You Can't Have One Without the Other." By reversing the order of things you can come up with this: God has an <u>operation or a plan</u>. If the wicked will return to God, he will <u>abundantly pardon</u>, giving him an <u>abundant life here</u> (1st Tim. 4:8). Eventually he will open that <u>abundant entrance</u> into the everlasting kingdom. However, none of these things would be available without the <u>abundant mercy of God</u>. Study the scriptures shown here and meditate on them and you will see how "You Can't Have One Without the Other!"
