### **LET'S MAKE A DEAL - SAYS THE DEVIL**

The Tax Collector, Matthew, in the fourth chapter of his gospel beginning at verse one, records what has long been called the "Temptation Chapter" of the Bible. You should know that I'm talking about the temptations which the devil presented to Jesus. Notice first of all, Satan always picks his time to offer us his best deal. In the case of Jesus, he had been fasting for forty days and nights. Naturally he was hungry. Knowing the power of Jesus, this was a great opportunity for Satan to make his first deal. He said, "If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread" (Matt. 4:3). Next, he tested Jesus by taking him to the pinnacle of the temple with much the same plea, "if thou be the Son of God cast thyself down and see if God will send his angels to rescue you." The biggest deal which Satan threw at Christ was to offer him all the kingdoms of the world - as if they were his to offer. In each case Christ countered with "It is written" thus showing the power of the Word of God. Often the tempter implants in our mind some "deal" which puts our faith to a test and so often we fall into his snare. "Lord, if you will do this, I will do that," we bargain. What a dangerous thing it is to think we can bargain with our Lord. God has his ways - he has his laws - he has his rules - and will not change any of them just for us. The sooner we learn this truth and respond to his will the happier our lives will be. God makes no deals outside of his promises.
