REFRESHING GOD'S PLAN OF SALVATION

The Bible teaches that the plan of salvation consists of five major steps each of which must be responded to from the heart (Rom. 10:9-10). First, it becomes necessary to hear the gospel preached. According to scripture our "faith comes from hearing and hearing by the word of God" (Rom. 10:17). Once we hear something that does not come from the word of God, however convincing it may sound, we need to abandon that approach immediately. When we learn to focus completely on the word of God and believe it without question, then we are "not far from the kingdom of God" (Mark 12:34). After this comes the necessity of looking at our past and facing the future with a determination to make a complete change in our relationship to God and his church. This is called repentance! As interest continues in getting right with God, you "search the scriptures" (John 5:39), and see where Jesus requires a public confession that he is the Son of God (Matt.10:32; 16:16). You also see that by command (Mark 16:15-16) and example you must be baptized for the remission of your sins (Acts 2:38). When these simple steps are obeyed from the heart, according to Acts 2:47, you are then "added to the church" and ready to start your journey with the Lord to the end of your life (Rev. 2:10). As OLD as this plan is, it can create a NEW person and make them "a vessel unto honor, sanctified, and useful for the Master's use" $(2^{nd} Tim. 2:21)$.
