We don't have a detailed account of the childhood of Jesus, but what we do know is quite instructive about the ingredients that belong in the mix of the development of a child. A reading of the second chapter of Luke serves as a reminder. There are parents who are sincerely devoted in their service to the Lord and thoughtfully attentive to the growth of the child. There is involvement in a support system consisting of people who love the cause of the Lord, who make it their custom to worship him, and who treat each other with understanding and affection. There is a child who grows under watchful care, learns to be submissive to his parents, and begins to take an interest in matters larger than himself. In such a setting, over time, there is the maturing of a balanced human being: that child turns into an intellectual, physical, spiritual, and social grownup.

We believe that is the kind of process that is meant to happen in our families, and that, each time it does, it in its own way changes history for the better. When we meet as the church and rejoice in little ones, or have Bible classes for children, or provide camp sessions for teens, or are otherwise a faithful spiritual presence in each other's lives, God uses us as partners in the most important human project: the healthy and balanced development of human beings.
