“We give thanks...for all of you...remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Thes. 1:2-3).

“But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love and reported that you always remember us kindly....For now we live, if you are standing fast in the Lord” (1 Thes. 3:6, 8).

“But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation” (1 Thes. 5:8).

“We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing. Therefore, we ourselves boast about you in the churches of God for your steadfastness and faith in all your persecutions and in the afflictions that you are enduring” (2 Thes. 1:3-4).

“Finally, brothers, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may speed ahead and be honored, as happened among you, and that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men. For not all have faith....May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and the steadfastness of Christ” (2 Thes. 3:1-2, 5).

The world is confusing. Our job is not. We want to practice faith, love, and hope, each in the application circumstances require.
