Like the chorus in a great song, there are themes Paul returns to again and again as he encourages the church of the Thessalonians. Readers are left with the impression that these are the great concerns of a congregation. We underline to highlight the recurring notes.

"We give thanks...for all of you...remembering before our God and Father your work of <u>faith</u> and labor of <u>love</u> and steadfastness of <u>hope</u> in our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Thes. 1:2-3).

"But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your <u>faith</u> and <u>love</u> and reported that you always remember us kindly....For now we live, if you are <u>standing fast</u> in the Lord" (1 Thes. 3:6, 8).

"But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation" (1 Thes. 5:8).

"We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your <u>faith</u> is growing abundantly, and the <u>love</u> of every one of you for one another is increasing. Therefore, we ourselves boast about you in the churches of God for your <u>steadfastness</u> and faith in all your persecutions and in the afflictions that you are enduring" (2 Thes. 1:3-4).

"Finally, brothers, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may speed ahead and be honored, as happened among you, and that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men. For not all have <u>faith</u>....May the Lord direct your hearts to the <u>love</u> of God and the steadfastness of Christ" (2 Thes. 3:1-2, 5).

The world is confusing. Our job is not. We want to practice faith, love, and hope, each in the application circumstances require.
