Equipping the Saints (Including the Kids) for Ministry

"He gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the <u>equipping of the saints for the work of ministry</u>, for the edifying of the body of Christ" (Ephesians 4:11,12).

One of the unfortunate consequences of designating church staff members as "ministers" is the impression often left that "ministry" is something that is done by those whom a church chooses to employ. The word of Paul cited above belies that assumption, as for Paul, the body of believers was to be edified through ministry performed <u>by the saints</u>. And that preparation for ministry was to be supplied through the equipping of those in the leadership roles listed previously. Ministry is something all can and *should* be doing!

The LTC (Leadership Training for Christ) program, in which we participate each year, is part of our effort to "equip the saints," at least as I see it. Our goal in what we do is to attempt to provide to the young participants the opportunity and skill to be functioning, productive citizens of the Kingdom of God. Through a plethora of various events, we can help our kids see that "Leadership" does not always mean being an elder, deacon or preacher, or the wife of one of those men. Rather, leadership in the kingdom has many faces, none of which is more important than the others.

Today is the day that we begin the journey preparing for LTC conference 2016. I hope that if you are a parent of 3-12 graders, you will encourage your kiddos to look through the packet and find something that interests him/her, then help them learn about that particular avenue of service and how it can be of benefit to the kingdom. We would love to help and coach them along the way!

I also hope that, if you are not a parent of kids this age, that you will encourage those who are, and encourage those kids who participate. I hope you will see the value in teaching these young people these skills, even those which may not be as obvious to you to be leadership, and help them to see the place they have in the kingdom.

I mentioned in the title that equipping the saints should include equipping the children, and that part of our role as a body of believers is preparing our children to find their place in the body, to see their lives as meaningful and useful for ministry, and to see that they are important in the life of our congregation. LTC helps us do these things, and it is our prayer that you will partner with us in our work for these young kids. - Adam



Sympathy




We extend our sympathy to Teresa Mahon and her family in the loss of her mom, Thelma Fain, who passed away last Saturday evening. Services were held Saturday.
