The Imperatives Of Fulfilled Ministry

Second Timothy is the last letter of a man who has fought the good fight, written as he himself is already being offered. It is addressed to a younger coworker who is like a beloved son to him, one who will have to fulfill his own ministry in the continuance of that fight. The tone is warm and calm, but there is a sense of urgency that is expressed in the imperatives Paul presents to Timothy.

<u>Rekindle the use of your own ability.</u> "For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands, for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control" (2 Tim. 1:6-7).

<u>Hold to what you have heard and guard it like a treasure.</u> "Follow the patten of the sound words that you have heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. By the Holy Spirit who dwells within us, guard the good deposit entrusted to you" (2 Tim. 1:13-14).

<u>Pass the gospel of grace along to others</u>. "You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus, and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also" (2 Tim. 2:1-2).

<u>Remember Christ and remind everyone not to be distracted from him.</u> "Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, the offspring of David, as preached in my gospel...Remind them of these things, and charge them before God not to quarrel about words, which does no good but only ruins the hearers" (2 Tim. 2:8, 14).

<u>Aim to please God in the use you make of his word.</u> "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15).

Engage in pursuits that are worthy of God's household. "So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart" (2 Tim. 2:22).

<u>Continue in what you have firmly believed despite difficulties.</u> "But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty...But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it" (2 Tim. 3:1, 14).

Imperatives are things that have to be attended to with urgency. The things Paul asked of Timothy are crucial to the ongoing health of the church. "But you yourself must keep calm and sane at all times; face hardship, work to spread the Gospel, and do all the duties of your calling" (2 Tim. 4:5, NEB).



ENCOURAGEMENT STANDS AT THE TOP OF THE LIST WHERE FELLOWSHIP IS CONCERNED

The story of the Apostle Paul, especially his three missionary journeys, his voyage to Rome, plus all the hardships and heartaches which befell him made his life a great metaphor for our own lives. He had many reasons for giving up his mission of being the apostle to the Gentiles but never did he entertain turning back. One of the things that made him keep on going was because he was encouraged in his work. Especially was this true when he was nearing the end of that long and difficult journey to Rome. Others in Rome knew of his coming and went out to meet him. What a great lesson for us who need encouraging as well as to those who need to be encouragers. When Paul saw this group of fellow Christians, "he thanked God, and took courage" (Acts 28:15). No doubt this was just what he needed to give him the reassurance of his mission. From then on, what a great work he did for the Lord. Many of his epistles were written while Paul was imprisoned in that large city of Rome. How often we all are made to share in his successes especially when we are nearing the end of our journey. The beloved epistle to the Philippians was written while Paul was a prisoner and away from those whom he loved. Consider the following: "I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now" (Phil. 1:3-5). Much is said today about fellowship in the church. Surely the idea of encouragement, based on the teachings of scripture, goes a long way and stands at the top of the list where genuine fellowship is concerned.
