Psalm 143 is the prayer of one who values his own soul accordingly. His pleas for the Lord's mercy are expressed as he works his way through a troubled time. It may be that we can think of our soul's journey of faith, too, as listen in on his. Watch for "my soul."

For the enemy has pursued my soul; he has crushed my life to the ground; he has made me sit in darkness like those long dead. (v. 3)

I stretch out my hands to you; my soul thirsts for you like a parched land. (v. 6)

Let me hear in the morning of your steadfast love, for in you I trust.

Make me know the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul. (v. 8)

For your name's sake, O LORD, preserve my life! In your righteousness bring my soul out of trouble! (v. 11)

And in your steadfast love you will cut off my enemies, and you will destroy all the adversaries of my soul, for I am your servant. (v. 12)

The message of the New Testament is precious against the background of a prayer like this. Christ comes to give rest to the souls of those who submit to him. His gospel purifies souls. In him, we can entrust our souls to a faithful Creator. We have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of our souls!
