Come To Church

From the earliest days of the existence of the Lord's church, its members have needed to be together. Acts indicates that the first Christians had a practice of gathering together (cf. 2:46; 14:27; 20:7). The epistles assume that there will be occasions when the whole church will come together (I Cor. 11:18; 14:23). It seems to have always been the case that it is assembling together which gives expression to fellowship and identity to the church.

But it also seems to have always been true that Christians need to be reminded not to neglect to meet together. When familiarity, weariness, distraction or offense begins to settle in, the habit of absence often follows (cf. Heb. 10:25). We sometimes try to correct the problem with some utilitarian appeal to the selfishness of people. The scriptures, however, address it with meaningful spiritual principles.

For example, meeting together is mentioned in the context of drawing near to God. Those who are members of his household by reason of obedience to the gospel express their confidence in Christ, the sincerity of their hearts, and the full assurance of their faith by coming together (cf. Heb. 10:19-22). Where there is an interest in entering the holy places by the new and living way, there will be an appetite for assembling together.

Also, continuing to meet together is brought up in connection with holding fast the confession of our hope (Heb. 10:23). The habit of assembling helps keep hope from wavering. Dependable presence is a reflection of the faithful character of the one whose promise is the basis of our hope.

Finally, one's presence when the church comes together is a crucial means of stimulating love and good works within the church (Heb. 10:24). One member has it within his power to either stir up or dishearten the others. He shows that he cares about the influence he may have upon his brothers and sisters by being there.

Draw near to your Father. Be true to your confession. Strengthen your brothers. Come to church.


