Generations in the Same Story

What a beautiful thing! Not only has it been on our minds this weekend, but it has also been observable in our Bible readings this past week. It is what happens when generations who love the Lord are interacting with each other in the same story.

It is as necessary as life. It is the only way permanent realities can remain a possession of temporary beings. One who is facing the time when strength is spent prays, "O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim your wondrous deeds. So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come" (Ps. 71:17-18).

That noble longing is answered in the experience of Simeon and Anna (Lk. 2:25f, 36f). Both are devoted servants of God, far along in years, waiting for the consolation to be brought by the Lord's Christ. When, forty days after his birth, he is presented to the Lord at the temple, Simeon takes him in his arms and blesses God, telling of the impact this child's life will have. Anna starts thanking God and speaking of him to all who are waiting for redemption. Now they feel as if they can depart in peace.

But there is a natural reality about it. Their fulfillment occurs through the practical dedication of two representatives of younger generation, Mary and Joseph (Lk. 2:22f). As written in the Law of the Lord, they make the journey to present the child to the Lord and to offer the sacrifice of the poor for his mother's cleansing. They attend to responsibility, marvel at what is said, and accept the risk of having the souls pierced through. They are blessed, but not cheaply. No wonder they become a blessing.

And attention is soon focused on yet another generation—the new one to which Jesus belongs (Lk. 2:39f). He lives in a regular place and is cared for by a family in a community. He grows physically, mentally, and spiritually. In other words, he interacts with other generations, and oh how he blesses them!

The LORD is God "to the thousandth generation" (Ex. 34:7). The most beautiful thing in the world occurs when multiple generations of those who love him understand themselves as actors together in the same story.
