Welcome, Spring

Spring officially makes its arrival this Lord's Day. Its approach has been announced for a while by early flowers, budding trees, and greening grass. Some occasional nip in the air, the lingering frosts, and a possible storm now and again are reminders that it takes a little time for a Season to settle in. But each one, especially Spring, is testimony to the faithfulness of God and to the nature of our own lives. We should notice, wonder, and consider.

It is very likely that there are spots in each of our lives that are like the face of the earth toward the end of the cold winter. Harsh conditions and unfavorable circumstances may have put our spirits near dormancy. It may be time for the renewal of our hopes, efforts, and affections. Perhaps this is when we should make use of the plea in Sylvia Rose Cobb's song:

Restore my Spirit, Lord, I need restored; My heart is weary, please help me, dear Lord. I stand in need of more strength from Your Word. Renew my love, rebuild my faith, O restore my soul.

Her song is based on the idea that the God who renews the earth can surely restore our cooled zeal into a new and warm desire to serve, or replace our doubt and fear with courage and faith. Surely that is right.

The writer of Psalm 104 also thought of the way the Lord God renews the face of the ground to give all his creatures their food in due season. As he considered, in one grand survey, the providential care of God, he found something happening in his own soul. He had a deep desire that the glory of the Lord might endure forever, and that he might sing to the Lord as long as he lived, and that the meditation of his heart might be pleasing to the Lord. We could say that a sort of springtime had come to his soul.

We must experience seasons of renewal like that. We need to remember that we were cleansed from our former sins and to embrace the joy that was ours when we first believed. We belong to a company who devote themselves to the apostles' teaching, and fellowship, and the breaking of bread, and prayers. Like tender but hardy plants springing up from the dirt to reach for the light, we aspire to the work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.
