"The God of The Spirits of All Flesh"

One of the most impressive designations of God in the scriptures is "the God of the spirits of all flesh." It is used in settings which suggest that it is deeply meaningful. It tells us something about the LORD which is to make a difference in our lives.

The phrase appears first as Israel is wandering through the wilderness. Moses addressed the LORD this way in the midst of the rebellion of Korah, Dathan and Abiram, and when he asked that Joshua be appointed to take his place (Num. 16:22, 27:16). In both cases, what was at stake was the authority that was to guide the people. That God is "the God of the spirits of all flesh" means that his dominion is universal.

He occupies this place by virtue of the fact that he is the source of the spirits of all mankind. He is "the Lord, who stretched out the heavens and founded the earth and formed the spirit of man within him" (Zech. 12:1). The God who is spirit made us in his own image. Our spirits are in his hand (Job 12:10), and when we die they return to him (Eccl. 12:7). All of us are responsible to "the God of the spirits of all flesh."

Such a God as this is able to accomplish what he wills and to do what he promises. He said, "Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh. Is anything too hard for me?" (Jer. 32:27). And the answer is, "It is you who made the heavens and the earth by your great power and by your outstretched arm! Nothing is too hard for you" (v. 17). "The God of the spirits of all flesh" can be trusted.

That's why we find our true selves and our richest life only in submission to his control and care. He is "the Father of spirits" (Heb. 12:9). He will work "for our good, that we may share his holiness" (v. 10). The high and lofty One who inhabits eternity will dwell with one who is of a contrite and humble spirit (Isa. 57:15).

Why not "be subject to the Father of spirits and live"?
