The Easiest Thing in the World

What do you think the easiest thing in the world is? I suggest that it may be <u>missing the point</u>. One line of evidence supporting this conclusion is the arrival of this particular weekend in May each year. It's not so much a religious point as it is a human nature one.

Memorial Day is a federal holiday set aside to honor members of the United States military who died in service to the country. It includes observances at various national cemeteries and a national moment of remembrance at 3:00 in the afternoon.

It was originally known as Decoration Day. In 1868, following the Civil War, an appropriate time for a national day of remembrance was sought. May 30 was chosen because it was not the anniversary of any particular battle. Citizens were to decorate the graves of those who had paid the price. The tradition of family remembrances were soon associated with the same time. With World War I the practice was renewed. In 1968 Congress moved it to the last Monday in May.

Now to most of us the last weekend in May means the official arrival of summer. We think not of what has happened there but of what begins here—the days out of town, the break from responsibilities, the time for ourselves.

I am not saying this is wrong. I am just calling our attention to an aspect of our nature of which we must be aware: it surely is easy for us to miss the point! We forget. We neither feel nor express gratitude. We make it about ourselves. We experience discontentment in the midst of privilege.

We citizens of the kingdom of heaven don't want to be overtaken by this tendency where even more important occasions are concerned. Consider the meaning of the Lord's day, for example. We come together to remember Christ. We are moved by gratitude. We think of building each other up. We experience peace. It is not always easy but it is always worth it.
