WV, Here We Come!

In 1873, John Muir, considered by most the Father of our National Parks system, wrote in a letter to his sister, "The mountains are calling, and I must go..." There was research and work to be done in those mountains in the West, and Muir answered the call. Our Water Mill Youth group has received a call from the mountains in the East, specifically from a congregation of the Lord's people in the Appalachian mountains, and, like Muir, we intend to answer the call for work!

On Wednesday, 27 of us will head east toward Lewisburg, WV, where we will spend 8 days working with the church there in that small mountain town. The congregation has about 80 members, only a few teenagers, and limited resources to be able to put together a memorable week of VBS for their community. So, our goal is to be able to bring our resources and young people and help in conducting a VBS week WITH them, involving as many of their people as possible. Our goal is to make a difference for their neighborhood, but even more, to show the people there what can be accomplished when members of the body put their efforts together. Our hope is to offer encouragement, ideas, resources, etc., so that the congregation can be more equipped to do it on their own in the future.

In addition to the VBS work, we have tons of other plans, as well. We have service work planned for nearly every morning in their local communities. Everything from yard work at members' homes and the church building, to work for a local Family and Women's refuge center (a safe haven for abused women), to work for a boarding house for families of women in the Federal Prison there. Needless to say, it is going to be BUSY week!

It will not be a vacation, by any means but a grueling week of work — decorating, cleaning, rehearsals, teaching, encouraging members, service work & physical labor, etc. Because of their commitment to take on such an important task, we'd like to recognize them, and ask that you offer your thanks to them, and request sincerely that you pray for each of them, and us as a group.


