ENCOURAGEMENT GOES A LONG WAY

The story of the Apostle Paul - his three missionary journeys - his voyage to Rome, plus all the hardships and heartaches which befell him made his life a great metaphor for our own life. He had many reasons for giving up his mission of being the apostle to the Gentiles but never did he entertain turning back.

One of the things that made him keep on going was because he was encouraged in his work. Especially was this true when he was nearing the end of that long and difficult journey to Rome. Others in Rome knew of his coming and went out to meet him. What a great lesson for us who need encouraging as well as to those who need to be encouragers. When Paul saw this group of fellow Christians, "he thanked God, and took courage" (Acts 28:15).

No doubt this was just what he needed to give him the reassurance of his mission. From then on what a great work he did for the Lord. Many of his epistles were written while Paul was imprisoned in that large city of Rome.

How often we all are made to share in his successes especially when we are nearing the end of our journey. The beloved epistle to the Philippians was written while Paul was a prisoner and away from those whom he loved. Consider the following: "I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now" (Phil. 1:3-5).


