#### <u>This Month at Water Mill</u>

December is several things. It's when plans are made, but also when time for what was planned runs out. It's both the joy of a holiday time and the melancholy of a passing year. It's a break from the routine with a busy schedule. It's peace and stress, giving and wanting, belonging and loneliness. But December is something else, too: it is opportunity to understand our faith, and to speak of it at a time when aspects of it have the imagination of our friends.

So let's do something great together this month at Water Mill. Let's look a bit more carefully into what the Lord's having become a sharer in flesh and blood means in the great purpose of God. Let's appreciate how his having been born in the likeness of men-how what he did by becoming flesh and dwelling among us-so powerfully impacts our entire way of thinking and living that it sustains us all the way through whatever life brings.

Here's how we can approach it in a way that will allow us to focus and follow a line of thought. We will use the great Letter to the Hebrews–the word of encouragement, its writer calls it. We already love it for that reason, and because of its references to other scriptural practices and characters, and because of its spotlight on the superiority of Jesus, the Son, the Christ, our Lord.

But it's the other ways the epistle refers to him that are so intriguing and instructive. The writer uses the phrases of Jesus almost in passing. We might call them the "this is who Christ is to his people" words, or the "this is what he means to us" pictures, or "this is why he is worth it" terms. Here are some of them: the founder of our salvation, the apostle and high priest of our confession, the source of eternal salvation, a forerunner on our behalf, the guarantor and mediator of the new covenant, the founder and perfecter of our faith, and the great shepherd of the sheep.

This month in our meetings, Sunday mornings and Sunday evenings, we'll take these one at time and consider their lessons to us. We'll be the richer for it. Each picture is loaded with meaning to both challenge and encourage. We hope you can be with us.
