The unexpected call comes, the unimaginable series of events unfolds, and the unspeakable sense of loss is left. That is the old process that began anew for us Thursday evening, and very personally. We are missing a sister so precious to us, and a family so dear to us is bearing the unbearable, and all of us are trying to be of some support to each other.

Through these few hours I have been making mental notes of realities in this process that have re-impressed me. May I share a few of them with you?

We take mornings and evenings for granted, but it really is true that we do not know what a day may bring forth. Bad things happen in the world. They happen in a moment. Life is uncertain in a way that has the capacity to leave us in shock.

This is the kind of thing from which the Lord wants so badly to rescue us. There is no glossing over reality with him. He considers death an enemy to be destroyed. He is engaged in a patient, costly, loving project to do so.

Not even the Lord can love us and make us capable of loving him and each other without our also being capable of experiencing the hurt of loss. Real love is vulnerable. But, it is worth whatever happens.

One life lived for the Lord certainly touches many other lives. Knowing how fleeting we are, we should express our love and respect to his servants who have blessed us while we have time.

The Lord's people want—and need—to be together. For us to seek each other's presence is like an instinct in life's most meaningful moments. We care for one another. When one suffers, all of us suffer together.

Congregational life is so important. It is in the day to day, week after week, laboratory of life and work as a local church that people who are prepared for realities like these are built. There is no partnership like it.
