What Everybody Is Saying

VATER MILL HURCH OF CHRIST

Any observer of public discourse will notice it. A statement or an action or an idea gets in the news of the day wherever you look. Before long a narrative forms about it and begins to shape popular opinion. Soon a view is assumed as what everybody thinks.

We live in a social and intellectual environment which attaches weight to what is regarded as conventional wisdom. I have been reflecting on our recent readings with this in mind. What if I try to hear John while valuing what everybody is saying?

Consider our passages just from the last week or two. First there is Nicodemus. He is conscientious about the scriptures, respected among his people, and honest about Jesus. After nightfall, this ruler comes to Jesus and says, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him" (Jn. 3:2).

Next comes the Samaritans from the town of Sychar. It was not usual for anyone like Jesus to have dealings with them, much less to ask a drink of a woman out at the well in the middle of the day, and even less to be able to tell her all she ever did. After spending some time with him, they said to her, "It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Savior of the world" (Jn. 4:42).

Then there is the man who has been blind all his life. He goes and washes his eyes as Jesus sends him to do and comes back seeing. He may expect to be met with rejoicing; instead he faces critical examination over what he thinks of the one who opened his eyes. He says of Jesus, "He is a prophet...If this man were not from God, he could do nothing...Lord, I believe," and he worshiped him (Jn. 9:17, 33, 38).

So do I. In fact, it seems to me that one of the few places where it is socially acceptable to contradict what everybody says is where people in a position to know about Jesus speak of him. Here, of all places, it might be good to listen to what everybody is saying.
