#### A LOOK AT THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Over the last several years the Ten Commandments, which had their beginning in the time of Moses (Exod. 20), have taken a beating here in the Land of the Free and the Home of the Brave. However, long before the laws of our land ruled that these great truths could not be displayed in the hallowed halls of our land even some in the church wanted to keep them strictly in the Old Testament. Time and space does not allow my going further into that discussion but may I suggest that all of these wonderful directives have been repeated by various writers of the New Testament with the exception of the law of the Sabbath and are just as valid today as they were when Moses, at God's command, set them in stone hundreds of years before Christ was born. Before going further may I suggest looking at the following passages: (Rom. 2:22-23: 13:9; 15:3; Matt. 5:17-18;43-44; 22:37-40).

Taking another look at these Ten Commandments, outside of Matthew 22:37-40 where we observe that Jesus mentions the degree of loving God as the "first and great commandment and the second is like unto it, thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself," they then are all on equal footing one with another as to their level of importance with God. It is also interesting to see how some look at one forbidden sin and make it more or less important than another. For example, we still have laws pertaining to stealing, as is true with committing murder, but in such areas as committing adultery or taking the name of the Lord in vain, we simply wink at such and mark it off as "Oh well, everyone does it!"

Moving now into the area of "high tech" are we so naive to think we can change right into wrong and wrong into right with the clicking of a button? Today, we can hack into another's computer and steal his social security number, and even some of his private and personal history without any thought of what God must be thinking about us. In other words, when God gave to Moses these Ten Commandments it would be some hundreds of years until the "law of liberty" (James 1:25) would include them again in the inspired writings as mentioned in paragraph one above.

Today we would do well to fully understand that "God changes not" (Malachi 3:6) and basically neither do we, so without God's help we will never make it to that eternal city of God. Let us then put these treasured commandments back on the wall of our hearts and faithfully do our best to live by them. These wonderful words have guided generations over and around the rocky shoals of life and time giving then exceeding great and precious promises which are for this life and that which is to come. (See 1<sup>st</sup> Tim. 4:8 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Pet. 1:4).




