The people all around Houston are in are prayers. Our families have relatives, friends, or brothers and sisters in the Lord who are impacted by overwhelming flooding in the wake of Harvey. The danger, displacement, and destruction many of them are experiencing moves us with compassion.

It also brings us face to face with some realities about life in this world. Two of them are quite sobering, and two are deeply encouraging.

Consider first the truths which are always present, but which are being vividly imprinted upon our imaginations now. One is that none of our stuff will last. Our hearts break with families who are losing all their possessions—every keepsake, all their clothing, each furnishing, the whole house, and their entire life savings. But, whether gradually or suddenly, that will happen to us, too.

That, of course, is because we won't last either. At least not in this mortal body. It is as uncertain and as subject to being consumed as the things we gather for its care and enjoyment. This is the second sobering fact: each of us will go the way of all the earth. We have here no lasting city; we live in an earthly tent that is wasting away.

Yet, there are aspects of reality in the midst of these circumstances that impress themselves upon us and encourage us. At least, they will if we are thinking. One is the humanity that emerges—the good in people. So many put themselves out to help. Caring and kindness and generosity exist.

The other is the hope that is expressed. Could it ever be more obvious that human beings need to know that there is a brighter day ahead? How else would anyone have the heart to wait, to clean up, to start over, and to keep on anyhow. Hope set in God, not on the uncertainty of things, is a precious treasure, an anchor for the soul.

It seems to me that the moments in life the bring reality to light also make the value of the faith of Christ shine.
