Our Life Together

We have been praying for all who are in the path of Irma. It has been thought-provoking to watch Florida officials appeal to citizens to clear out of the storm's way while it could be done. One warned, "If you don't, we won't be able to save you then. If you call 911, there will be no answer." About the time I heard him say that, I noticed this in our reading for that day: "Besides this you know the time, that the hour has come for you to wake from sleep. For salvation is nearer to us than when we first believed. The night is far gone; the day is at hand" (Rom. 13:11-12a). That sounds a note of reality for all of us, doesn't it?

We got our new series in the auditorium class started Wednesday evening. We are going to try to think through what the scriptures say about <u>heaven</u>. That's where our citizenship is (Phil. 3:20). That's where the hope we've heard of in the gospel is laid up for us (Col. 1:5). It's where our inheritance is being kept (1 Pet. 1:4). No wonder the things we hear about heaven capture our imagination. So what does the Lord tell us about it? You are welcome to join us as we see.

One reason for my interest in this theme is that my Sunday morning class is reading James right now. James strongly reminds us of the practical, everyday implications of interest in heavenly things: meeting trials and temptations, hearing and doing, visiting the fatherless and the widow, words and actions, what lasts and what doesn't, patience and reverence. I am being reminded that my life needs both heavenly aspirations and earthly applications. All of our lives do.

In fact, that is largely what our work together is all about. We are trying to help people establish citizenship in heaven while there is time. We are also making an effort to give those who have done so the practical means of applying it in this world. That is why we constantly ask for your attention, involvement, and support—with your time, talent, and treasure—in what we are trying to do together for heaven's sake.


