The infrastructure of Puerto Rico was laid waste by hurricane Maria. Not only were buildings damaged or destroyed, but power and communication grids were also knocked out. Trees were downed, debris was scattered, and roadways were impacted. As I write, many people in outlying areas are still without the most basic necessities of life.

Several days after the storm, Governor Rossello of Puerto Rico was being asked about the needs of his people in a radio news report. He said they had a huge supply of bottled water sitting on pallets at the airport, and that thousands of shipping containers of food and other supplies were stacked at the seaport. Getting it to the people was the problem.

"Why?" the interviewer asked. "What do you need?" And the governor answered, "Truck drivers. We need all the truck drivers we can get!"

What a lesson for all of us. The essential tasks are not necessarily the ones that get the most attention or bring the most pay. They are the taken-for-granted ones without which very little else works.

It's that way in the body of Christ, too. God has composed the body so that the parts of it that seem ordinary are the indispensable ones. The greater honor belongs to the part that lacked it. There are no little jobs in the work the Lord does through his people to get the life-giving news of Christ to everyone everywhere.

What is needed is regular people like us, each taking our interest in the way of the Lord with us wherever we go in everyday life, and speaking favorably of it, while we are treating people as it says we should.
