Building a Tone of Gratitude Within a Congregation

First Thessalonians was written to a church having to get its feet on the ground and grow while facing opposition and without having had much time. It is instructive how often the note of thankfulness is sounded in the letter, and about what.

- 1. Notice, talk about, and give thanks for expressions of faith, hope, and love in the lives of members of the congregation. These readers are told that their work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope is always remembered and that thanks is constantly given for it before God (1 Thes. 1:2-3). Hearing this is sure to have a healthy impact on their image of themselves.
- 2. Give your brothers and sisters credit for taking the word of God to heart and believing it is at work in his people. Not everybody does, and how much the poorer any of us would be without these who do. It is a reinforcement for a people to learn that unceasing thanks is being made for its respect for God's word (1 Thes. 2:13).
- 3. Take joy in those who are standing fast in the Lord, and express it through thankful prayer for whatever is lacking. This kind of thanksgiving will involve having intentionally sought out good news about their faith and love, feeling joy over it, and being willing to help supply what is lacking (1 Thes. 3:6-10). Such realistic caring is truly encouraging.
- 4. Recognize the giving of thanks as an essential element in a way of life, not as an occasional emotion. That is what this letter calls for. Always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in all circumstances. This is God's will for his people (1 Thes. 5:15-18). And it is sure to set a tone.

Thanksgiving. Not a bad starting place for building a healthier congregation.




