How We Can Pray For Us

When Paul writes letters to churches that are dear to him, it is his practice to include expressions of his prayers for them. For example, after letting the Colossians know he has heard of the faith and love hope is causing in them, he says, "And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you..." (1:9). In the next few verses, he lists specific requests he is making for them.

As we make our way through this new year, we may all share in a ministry of intercessory prayer for the well-being of our congregation. We will do well to ask Heaven for the same blessings the apostle is seeking for them.

Increasing in the knowledge of God. Paul prays for them to be filled with knowledge of the Lord's will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding in such a way that they increasingly know their Father and are like him (1:9b, 10c). We may join him in asking that there may be a maturing love for God in the congregation.

Walking in a manner worthy of the Lord. His unceasing petition is that the congregation's fellowship with God may be reflected in daily practices and habits that are befitting his children. We can pray, too, for the church to have a manner of life worthy of the Lord, entirely pleasing to him (1:10a).

Bearing fruit in every good work. Paul's request of the throne of grace is that his brothers and sisters may be interested in all kinds of good works, actively involved in doing them, and being blessed with fruitfulness to Lord's glory (1:10b). We might pray with him that our congregation be doing all that our God can bless.

Being strengthened for endurance and patience with joy. The apostle knows that to endure this way requires the power that comes from his glorious might (1:11). He prays for the church to be strengthened with it, and we must, too. Who knows how our congregation will need it this year?

Giving thanks to the Father. Paul always prays that the church be animated with a spirit of gratitude to the One who has made them fit to share in the heritage of the saints (1:12). Let us also pray we may be a congregation of thankful hearts that are ruled by peace and serve with gladness.


