#### **About Our Work**

Usually, when I give an update on our work with our young people, I will title it "About Our YOUTH Work." I have decided against that today, just to make a small effort to encourage us all to think about our responsibility, as a congregation, in making sure the young people are brought to faith and nurtured along the way – not just by parents and a youth worker, but by our collective involvement in the ministry they require. I'd like to share some things that are going on which contribute to this work, and in which you might involve yourself!

- 1). We have invited **Luke Dockery**, Bobby's son & my friend, to come and present a workshop/seminar for us about what ministering to young people looks like as a ministry through the collective work of families of a congregation. Luke has done massive amounts of research in this area of "Youth in Family" ministry, and we've invited him to come share his findings to show the difficulties of raising kids to be faithful people when they leave home, the Biblical model of ministering to young people through the Physical and Faith Families, and the practical aspects of what Family-Based youth ministry looks like. We haven't nailed down the dates 100%, but be watching for more info.
- 2). We are going to begin a **Parents & Teens Combined Class** in March (Did you hear the collective sigh of the teenagers when I said that? Ha!). Our class will focus on the practical aspects of developing a faith that "sticks" when Youth Group life is over, and the role both parents and kids have in nurturing that. We would love to have ALL parents of our 7-12th graders in class, if possible. If you are a teacher in our young kids classes, feel free to talk to me if we can help you secure a teacher to cover your class for a quarter, so that you might be able to participate with us. Right now our target is to begin March 11 & run through the end of May or first week of June. Be watching for Info and praying for us!
- 3). LTC folks are plugging along in their work for Pre-convention & Convention events. Bible Quiz folks are working hard, Puppet & Drama kids have begun their Sundays of arduous prep work, & Song-leaders and Sermon deliverers are beginning soon. All of these in addition to the individual work being done on projects. PLEASE pray for them, encourage them, let them know you are proud of them, ask to hear about their work whatever you can do to let them know that what they are doing matters and has great value to the kingdom. Thanks!
- 4). Our annual turn to host the **Area Wide Youth Night is February 11**. First, PLEASE PLAN TO COME! You will not be disappointed in the singing and encouragement you will receive. Please support our kids' efforts in planning it. Second, we would like to ask you to please consider bringing some canned or bottled drinks AND/OR some desserts to help with the meal served to the kids afterward. You may begin bringing drinks immediately and place in the kitchen marked for youth night, and I will place a signup sheet for desserts to be brought the day of the event. We would so much appreciate your help!!!!!

Consider these activities not as part of "what the kids are doing," but as part of what you, as a congregation, are doing to help them see faith as valuable and viable in real life. Encourage them, involve yourself in their work and lives, and above all pray for them and for us! Blessings and grace!
