#### A Beloved Son

HTER MILL JURCH OF CHRIST

One brief, meaningful phrase might serve as our reference point when we are reading Mark: "my beloved Son." Both the spirit and the power of the unfolding drama is gathered up in it.

Right when Jesus comes up out of the water, having been baptized by John, a voice comes from heaven owning him as "my beloved Son." The Father expresses both affection for him and complete approval of his actions. In accordance with heaven's will, he is not only fully identifying with the human condition, but also fulfilling all righteousness. Far from insulating him from hardship, it sends him off to face the struggle of the wilderness.

When a crucial point comes in his ministry and he is transfigured before the three disciples he has taken up the mountain with him, the voice of glory says, "This is my beloved Son; listen to him." The point is that he has the right to speak, not as a peer of Moses and Elijah, but as their Lord. What he is saying about his mission, its costs, and its implications is what must be. All of us must respect him, depend on his work, and obey his teaching. There is neither someone else nor something else to rescue us.

And when he is in Jerusalem and the cross is near, he speaks the parable that may as well be his autobiography. An owner sends servant, after servant, after servant, to caretakers for his share of the produce. One after another, they are sent away empty-handed, treated shamefully, struck over the head, and killed. But that owner has "still one other, a beloved son." With astonishing grace, he sends even him, thinking, "They will respect my son." You and I know what happens. The caretakers kill him, too, and throw him out.

But he is still "the beloved Son." He becomes the cornerstone, the one either built upon, or crushed by. May we choose well what we do with him!


