That unfortunate juxtaposition will to many look like appropriate commentary. The idea that God does raise the dead is considered so incredible among them as to be the definition of foolish. The view isn't always an intellectual conclusion drawn through investigation and reason, either. With some it is a declaration of moral arrogance which looks with condescension upon anyone who allows for the possibility of any reality greater than self.

The Christian conviction is that God does raise the dead because he has. There is an empty tomb and a living Lord, and empowered witnesses to both, at the basis of our faith. That life has actually triumphed within real history in the experience of the Christ has been its central claim from fifty days after his death until now. It is celebrated every time his people gather in his name on the first day of the week, and every time someone obeying the gospel is raised up to live in a new way.

We believe in life. It seems to us that history, experience, and meaning demand that we do. It seems to us unwise, both intellectually and morally, to embrace death instead.
