Being Prepared to Make a Defense

As you know, we are currently in the middle of a series of responses to questions a gentleman cared enough to ask of us. We are offering answers because we expect that many of us wonder about these things, too, but we also have another purpose. It is to illustrate how we may go about something that is asked of us all. It's this: "but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect" (1 Pet. 3:15, ESV).

What Peter is calling us to do assumes some things about us. It assumes the church will be meeting, offering spiritual sacrifices, taking in these instructions, living the faith out in the community, and actively serving in word in deed. In other words, the assumption is that a people who honor Christ as Lord will be doing some things that might lead other persons to ask why.

And any of us who honor him as holy are called to be putting ourselves in a position to be able to say why. Is Christ your Lord? Is there hope in you? Why? What is your reason? None of us will be able to answer every question anyone may ask of us. People often wonder about things for which there is no scriptural answer! But any of us can benefit from the discipline of being able to put into words why we hope in Christ. And besides the blessings that will bring to ourselves, it will put us in position to bless.

The apostle says this is a task that is always to be attended to with a gentle spirit, with a tone of respect, and with a sincere conscience (the next verse adds). It's not just the answer that's important, but also the attitude. How could one know why he hopes in Christ and not be humbled by it? Pray for us that we may be heard that way, today and always.


