Our love to all of you. Have a great week! And be watching for the things you can do.

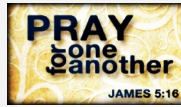

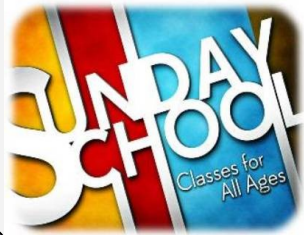
