### A Song for Us

In our work together these past six and a half years I've learned that Psalm 103 is one of Adam's favorites. I know it is quite meaningful to the rest of us too. A summary of it seems appropriate in expressing all our feelings just now.

God be thanked from the depth of our being (v. 1-5). We are beneficiaries of his goodness in many ways: we have been recipients of his forgiveness, healing, keeping, satisfaction, and renewal. We offer our gratitude to him, and to his servants through whom these blessings have often come.

God be himself to us in our continuing experience (v. 6-9). He wants to be known by his people. He revealed his heart in words and actions. It is his nature to be righteous, just, merciful, gracious, very patient, and rich in faithful love—all at the same time. We depend on his being this way, and we long to be like him with each other.

God deal with us according to a father's wise kindness (v. 10-14). O how much it means to us to recall that he knows our frame, understands how things impact us, and has compassion for us. He removes what is harmful, provides what is needful, and remains merciful to his family. His treatment of us is what binds us together.

God be the permanent reality throughout our journey (v. 15-19). Situations in our lives are as changeable as the flowers in the field. There are, however, everlasting things: his righteousness, his kingdom, and his promises to those who keep covenant with him. Such things remain as real in one generation or place as in another.

God be honored by everyone everywhere (v. 20-22). Because of who he is, it's his word, his will, and his dominion—and for his angels, his servants, his works, and our own souls—that's the thing for which we long.

And that's how it will finally be when our God gathers his people home again.
