I'm glad this interest came up as much as it did: how to spread the gospel/how to have a Bible study with someone/ where people who have done it share their ideas. Thank the Lord for brothers and sisters who have this goal in view! So I want to mention that the book our Thursday ladies class is using right now has within it a very useful and usable way to show a friend how to become a Christian. It's something you might want to look at.

Who we are and why we're here. In different ways, you expressed your desire for class to help our young people approach life with hope, and to be able to cope with it. Here are some of the ways it was said: what does it mean to be made in God's image/problems our culture influences us with and how to handle them/situations we are faced with on a daily basis. 
