HELP. Now what will help move us toward that goal? What will encourage you, involve you, and help you along that direction? What is an idea that you would consider helpful?

HOW. Then how is that thing that will help move us in the direction of our hopes to be done? Does it involve a who or a what? And how?

Now some of my own observations. First, of course our elders already have their own thoughts about these things, as do I, and we know the course forward will ultimately be determined by their leadership. Second, we all expect that a multitude of ideas will arise in our exchange of thoughts, and that we will not be able to pursue all of them at the same time. But third, I, at least, believe that we all should have responsibility in developing our vision if we expect to share the benefits together (and we do).

As sort of a preparation, our service this evening will revolve around the concepts mentioned above. Please plan to join us.


