It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away" (James 4:14), he could easily have asked, WHO is your life and WHY have you chosen to live it as perhaps you are presently! These three questions are indeed very important to our eternal destination. The <u>what</u> of our life is most important because it signifies the priority which we place on things in our life. Equally so the <u>who</u> will determine the reasons <u>why</u> we do (or not do) certain things. Consider the following passages, all of which show the values and importance of having Christ in our lives.

- (1) <u>"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I,</u> <u>but Christ liveth in me..." (Gal. 2:20)</u>. This simply means are we putting Christ first in our life in all things and are we using his written word as our divine authority to guide us in all things?
- (2) <u>"My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until</u> <u>Christ be formed in you" (Gal. 4:19).</u> Forming Christ is a process of growing. Just as a little babe must grow and grow until it reaches maturity the child of God must equally grow. (See 2nd Peter 3:18)
- (3) "....Christ shall be magnified in my body" (Phil. 1:20). In other words, live in such a way to enlarge the image of Jesus Christ in our life. (See Matt. 5:16)
- (4) <u>"When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye</u> <u>also appear with him in glory" (Col. 3:4).</u> This verse stands as the promise of all promises found in scripture and answers the third question of <u>WHY</u>? Surely we all must agree that our final goal and reward is answered in that old song - "<u>How Beautiful Heaven Must Be!"</u>

This last verse is the main purpose for our having Christ in our life. This should be the reason for all that we do through the Church for it is here that we may receive the proper training and preparing to making ourselves ready for his appearing. This same thought applies whether we see him "at his coming" or that we see him "face to face" when our time here on earth is over. Christ must always be in us! Think on these things. - Dennis R.
