How to Help Another Person Have Life

Jesus was clear about his purpose. "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly," he said (Jn. 10:10). He said it in other ways, but what he says and does is always so that people may life which is truly life.

Several statements made by our Lord illustrate how our faith in him fashions our thinking about what we can do for our friends and neighbors.

- For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost (Luke 19:10).
- Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you (Mark 5:19).
- Even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many (Matthew 20:28).

These and other sayings from each of the Gospels leave no doubt that following the Lord closely will involve us in sharing his purpose of opening the way of life—the abundant and eternal kind—to the people around us.

The question is how to transform what may exist within us as a general interest into specific intentional action. How can our vague desire to help someone we care about get to heaven someday turn into concrete effort to enable a real person we know walk in the light of the Lord right now? Many of us, I think, have struggled with this question enough to be basically inactive when it comes to passing along any news of life to our friends.

Part of the answer is taking the small step in front of you each day. Watch for any situation that needs hope or guidance introduced into it. Help in whatever way you can. Mention what your faith means in such a time. Speak positively about anything at church that has helped you. Suggest the encouragement that might come from something like *Know Your Bible* or some message available on our website. Use some of the notes in the Bible our elders are making available to us. Extend an invitation to class or to our services. Any one of these will at least be a beginning, far better than nothing at all, and may make all the difference for someone.
