The Abundance of the Heart

The line of thought in the latter half of the Lord's "Sermon on the Plain" is simple but profound (Lk. 6:37f). Judge others only in the spirit you would want expressed toward you. Set your attention on becoming like your teacher. Be aware of your own faults and seek to remove them first.

Why? Because that's what a good person does. And whether we are not one of them can be known by us.

Jesus makes the point with an illustration from plant life. The fact is that a tree is known by its fruit (44). A good tree produces good fruit. Figs are not gathered from thorn bushes, and grapes are not picked off brambles. And that's not a judgement; it's reality. Everyone knows it.

But the Lord is thinking of how his merciful and open-eyed disciples deal with themselves and other people. A good person, he says, produces good, and an evil person produces evil. And, he says, the reason this principle stands is that one's produce (what he speaks and does) comes out of his true heart (45).

The abundance of my heart is therefore the big issue of my life. What I allow to enter my heart of hearts, to linger there and to take root, in the most abundance is what will come out in my words and actions in the long run. The matters that I make into the abundance of my heart will turn into my personal identity.

Lord, help me to feed the good!

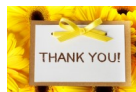
