**Area-wide Youth Night at Water Mill will be Sunday night, October 20.**

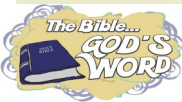
**We will provide a meal after the service so will need sandwiches, chips, cookies, canned drinks and water. Sign up at the Information Desk if you can help.**

### THURSDAY LADIES BIBLE CLASS

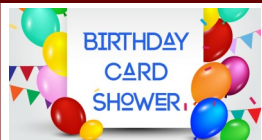
