BE AN ENCOURAGER!

If you really want to be an appreciated and fruitful servant of the Lord, be an encourager! An encourager is a ray of sunlight when the way is overcast. An encourager is someone who comforts those in sorrow, comes to the aid of those in trouble, cheers for those who are doing well, and urges everyone forward in love and good works. Anyone who serves as an encourager will be a precious blessing to people, for everyone needs encouragement.

Encouraging is special work, though. It is done by people who try to do it. There are at least three rules one must follow if he is to be an encourager.

Be present. Encouragement involves "just being there" more than any special knowledge or smart words. For example, those who have suffered loss are often strengthened more by the presence of their friends than by any advice. We can encourage good works by being there to help. We can encourage the church by our glad presence when it meets. No one has ever yet been able to encourage anyone by forsaking him (cf. Heb. 10:24-25).

Be positive. By this we do not mean that one should ignore difficulties or gloss over problems. But we are saying that if one is to be an encourager he must be able to pick up on the good points of people and circumstances. Anyone can point out problems and weakness—in fact, that's often the very reason we need encouragement! The encourager has the vision to see possibilities and opportunities. He takes this outlook because he leans on the promises of God. With Paul he says, "I can do all things through him who strengthens me" (Phil. 4:13).

Be patient. An encourager does not panic over the problems of the moment. He is sympathetic and accepting, as Jesus was with the little children (Mk. 10:13f), as Barnabas was with Saul (Acts 9:27), and as Priscilla and Aquila were with Apollos (Acts 18:26-27). An encourager does not give up, give out, or give in. Instead, the encourager believes things can get better and joins in the effort to bring improvement.

Everybody wants the encouragement. Who will do the encouraging?
