Words of the Year

Words are powerful. A word may not only impact many lives, but also reflect what is going on in them–what is valued, what the mood is, what the concerns are. The "2019 Word of the Year" choices that are currently being published are examples.

Have you noticed any of them? Dictionary.com nominates "existential" as its word of the year. A bit ominous, it reminds us that our very being is in question. Oxford Dictionaries chose a phrase for their word of 2019: "climate emergency." It fits a religiously fervent political priority of many. Macquarie Dictionary, an Australian one, identifies "cancel culture" as the term that reflects the time–a time when opposing thoughts are shouted down and unwanted history is supposed to never have happened.

Here's one that reflects the cultural climate of our age in a different way. It's the Merriam-Webster choice for the 2019 Word of the Year: the little personal pronoun "they." In September this dictionary expanded the definition of "they" as "relating to a person whose gender is non-binary." This year "they" became a singular third-person pronoun.

What are we to make of the spirit of a time which is thought to be best summarized by words or phrases like these? Without meaning to attack anyone, don't they suggest a tone of pessimism? Anxiety and conflict? Self absorption? Sounds that way to me.

So my 2019 Words of the Year are contained in this verse: "So now *faith*, *hope*, and *love* abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love" (1 Cor. 13:13). Three concepts which, together, reflect the mood, the values, and the concerns of the Lord's people this year. And I'll go ahead and tell you: these will be our Words of 2020, too.
