Four Blessings A Prayer-Guide for Us

In mid-March, we plan to begin the process of identifying additional brothers to help us as shepherds and servants, elders and deacons. The early church approached times like this with prayer (Acts 6:6; 14:23). It is appropriate that we do the same. But how do we pray about a thing like this? What do we ask for?

Sunday evening we suggested that, as a basic outline for our prayers during this time, we ask the Lord together for four blessings. Some of you asked that we print them for us all to keep. Here, then, in a brief form, is a prayer-guide we might use.

Lord, give us brothers who will accommodate...

- <u>Faithfulness.</u>...Brothers who will treat the church like it belongs to You, who will be alert to its needs, and who will help us be true to the word of Your grace (Acts 20:28-31)...Brothers who, along with their families, will build a following for you within a congregation, not a following for themselves in a sub-group of it.
- <u>Fellowship....</u>Yes, unity and togetherness, but even more than that...Not brothers to do things for us, but brothers who will facilitate our all doing what we are good at like You want us to...Every one of us, like members of one body (Rom. 12:4-8) ...That kind of fellowship.
- <u>Fruitfulness....</u>Brothers who, in their functioning as overseers and deacons, can enable everything that will fill us with the fruit of righteousness... Brothers who can contribute to more love, deeper understanding, and increasing approval of what is excellent in Your sight (Phil. 1:1, 9-11).
- <u>Fulfillment.</u>...Brothers whose presence, like the Chief Shepherd whom they serve, will provide a sense of satisfaction, well-being, rest, renewal, and direction among us (1 Pet. 5:4; Psalm 23:1-3)...Brothers whose efforts will allow a healthy tone to always exist here.
