Renewed Day by Day

It happened in just more than a week. We gained a day and lost an hour! Leap Day and Daylight Saving Time: add a day to February; skip an hour of Saturday night. You could say that's a metaphor for how life is—more good than bad, but definitely a mixture.

That is one reason our faith is so precious. Our faith gives us a perspective toward what is happening as we are experiencing that mixture. "Our inner self is being renewed day by day" in all of it, and through it all (2 Cor. 4:16).

We can understand renewal from the world around us, particularly at this time of the year. Springtime approaches, and plants begin to come to life, trees start budding out, and birds turn brighter colors and begin building nests. Life is renewing itself.

What's not so clear is how that happens to us day by day, but when you see through eyes of faith, it's there. We bless the LORD for all his benefits and our vitality is renewed (Ps. 103:2-5). We wait for him and our strength is renewed so that we can rise to the demands of life (Isa. 40:31). We give him ourselves in gratitude for his mercies, and renewed in the spirit of our mind (Rom. 12:1-2; Eph. 4:23). Our faith informs us that we have put on the new self, which is being renewed after the image of its creator (Col. 3:10).

Renewal. It is that time of the year. And, some of the things we are needing to do in our congregational life are expressions of the fact that where there is life, there is renewal. Just remember that there are elements of it every day in the life of every child of God. "Our inner self is being renewed day by day."
